This very handsome watch has a strong wrist presence at 45mm. The recognizable **Navitimer** dial is in a bronze tone which pops out in the light. One does not just have to be a **Navitimer** lover to appreciate the beauty in this watch. The version shown is in stainless steel.

NOMOS GLASHÜTTE

We always say that everything **Nomos Glashütte** does, they do very well. In 2017, this remains true, and we can choose any of their new releases and put it on this list, but we settled with the new and improved **Nomos Glashütte Ahoi Neomatik**. Most obvious, they have introduced new vibrant colour choices (blue and red) to the dial. There is also a smaller case size at 36.3mm and the updated automatic movement can be viewed through the sapphire crystal caseback. Feel comfortable getting this watch wet – it is waterproof up to 200 meters.

GLASHÜTTE ORIGINAL

The new **Glashütte Original Senator Chronograph Panorama Date** is a modern take on a beautiful watch. It has the same beautiful in-house flyback chronograph movement which can be seen through the sapphire crystal caseback and takes up the same amount of wrist space at 42mm. What's new is the stainless steel case, the black dial, and the application of blue Super-LumiNova on the indexes, and the minute and hour hands. This sporty version looks awesome.
